Teenager hit by Amalgamated bus

ALYSSA Thomas, a Form One student of Bishop's Anstey High School in Trincity is now in hospital, after she was run over by a security truck in Arouca.

According to reports, at about 7.35 am yesterday the 12-year-old girl had alighted from a maxi near Railway Road.

The maxi which was east bound on the Priority Bus Route, was about to cross the northern side of the road. At the same time an Amalgamated Security vehicle with the licence plate TDC 6668 was transporting prisoners along the Priority Bus Route.

Newsday understands the vehicle was being escorted by police officers at the time. Thomas walked out from between two maxis, and in the path of the Amalgamated Security Bus.

Thomas was hit by the bus and was thrown several feet in the air. Emergency services were immediately contacted and officers of the Arouca police services responded. She was rushed to the Eric Williams Medical Sciences Complex in Mount Hope, where she remains warded.

Newsday understands that the young girl sustained internal bleeding, and broken bones from the accident
